The children were asked to write a speech for Paul, reflecting on his life's mission. Here is Alan Rostocki's fantastic example.

My Dear friends,

I have put up with many things – some good and some bad. All sorts of trials and difficulties. I have been whipped and beaten for what seems like forever. I have worked hard and been forced to work like a slave and servant.

As I am writing this I am in prison being tortured and trapped for what feels like an eternity but the Holy Spirit has kept me going. In fact, many of my letters have been written in jail.

I have been shipwrecked, forgotten and abandoned – even being shipwrecked did not stop me! It never will, as I will always carry on God's Mission. My journeys have varied in sizes and places. Some I only went to once, others many times.

I have made many friends and formed Christian communities in places like Rome, Corinth, Galatia, Ephesus and Phillipi (to name just a few). However, I have also made many enemies – I have been praised and worshipped by some and blamed and hated by others.

They called me a nobody but yet everybody knew my name. They called me a liar but I only ever told the truth. They said my life wasn't worth living, but I have enjoyed every moment of it!

Many things have made me sad, but I have been a very happy man. I will continue to be happy because I have your prayers and the spirit of Jesus to strengthen me.
