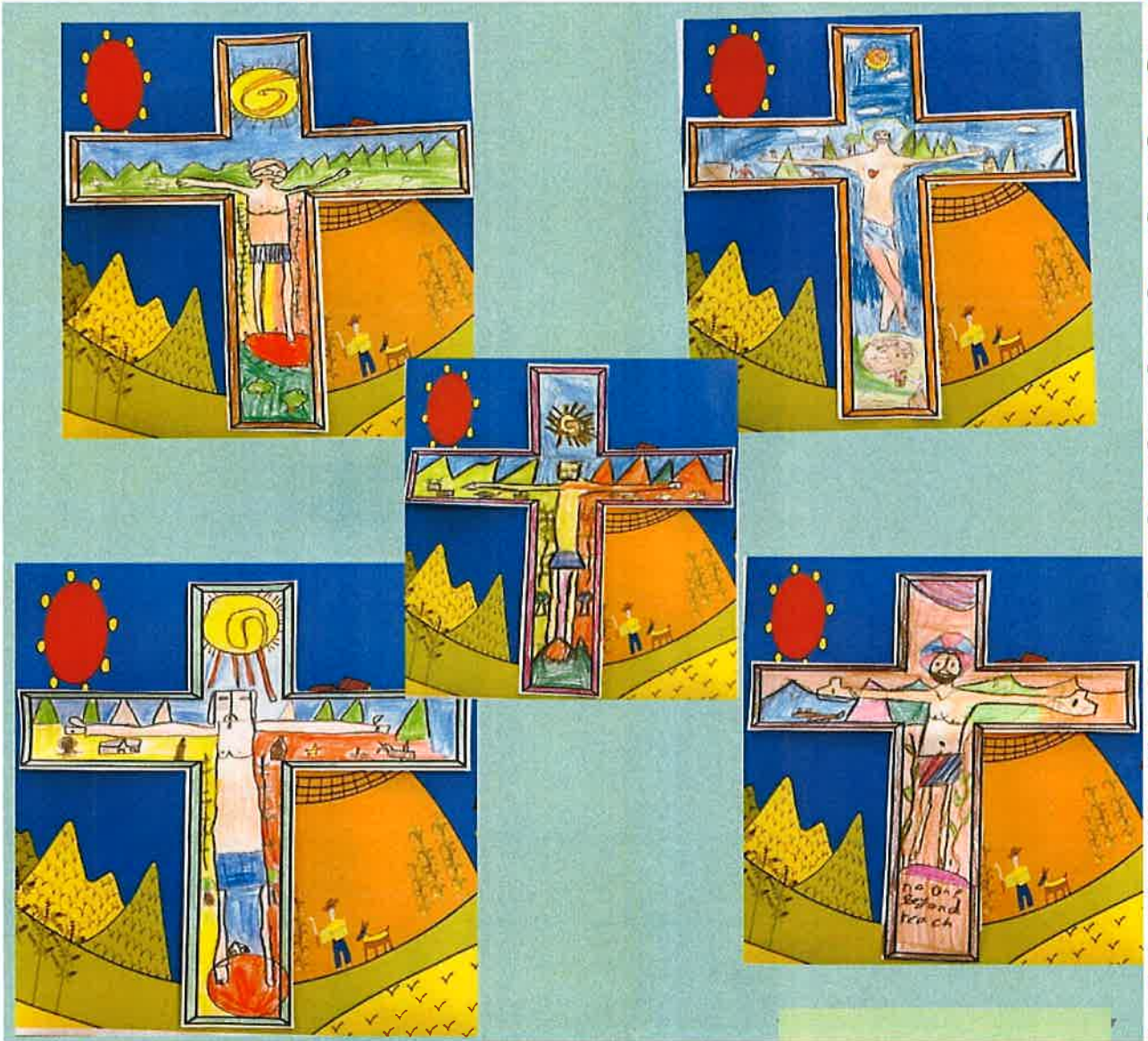
Saint Oscar Romero.
