Class Three



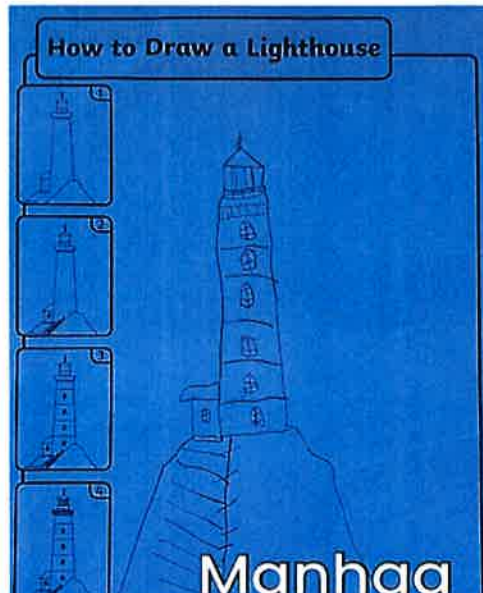
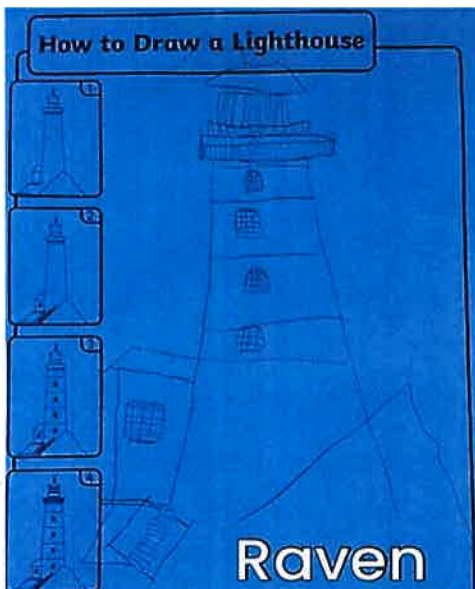
This week in Class Three we have continued with our context topic Beach Combers. Mrs Richards kindly bought us two octopuses and a squid to explore.



We explored the octopus and squid closely and touched them.



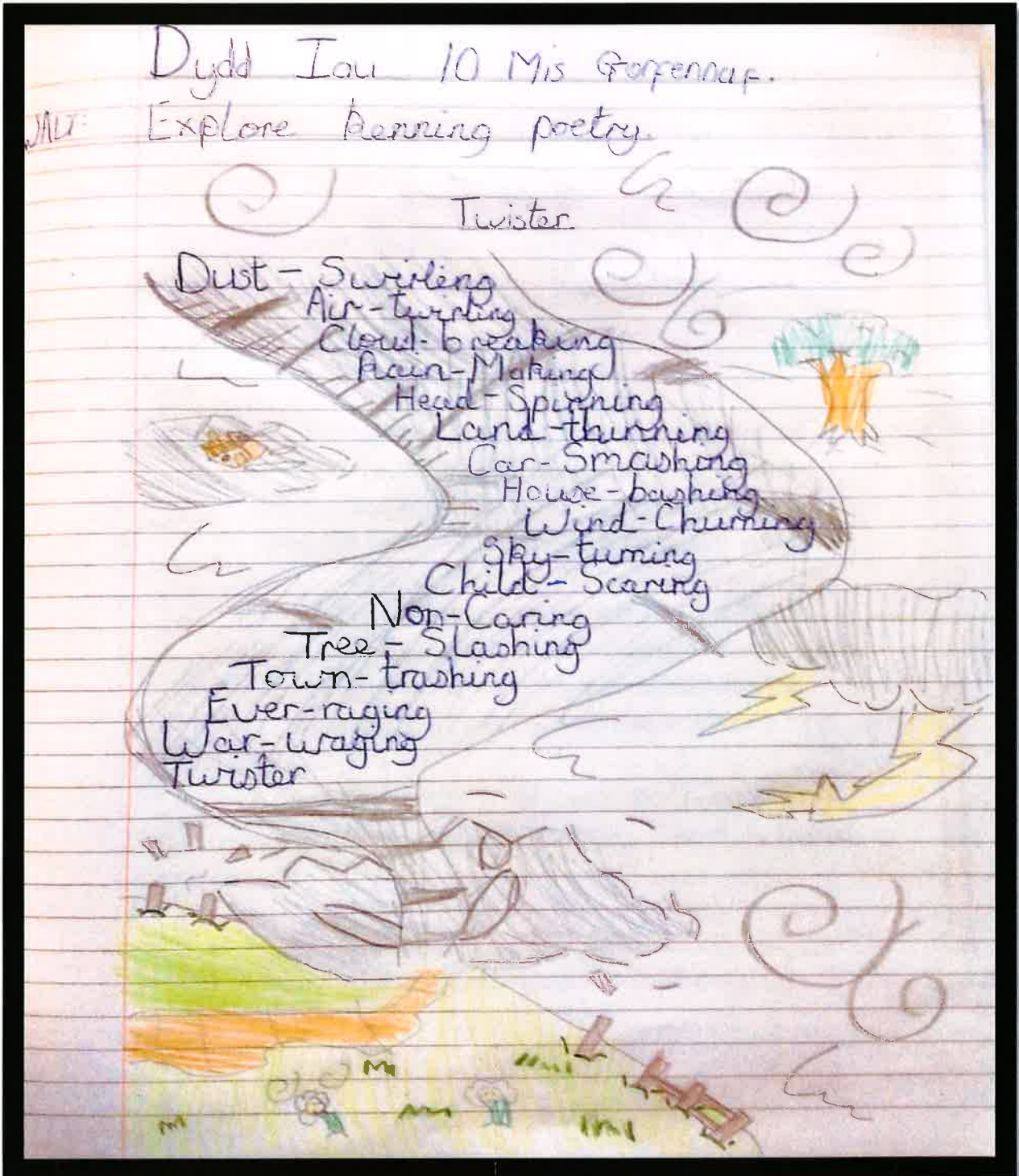
This week we read the story of The Light House Keeper's Lunch. We have started to learn about the importance of lighthouses and developed our expressive arts skills whilst drawing them.
