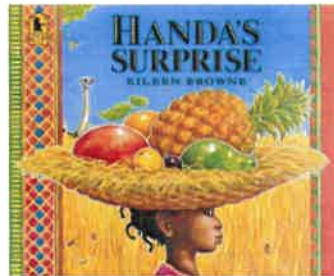

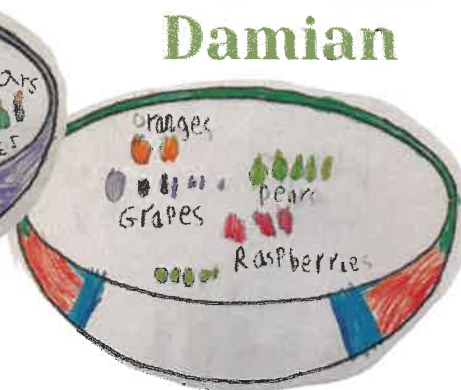


We chose our favourite fruit from the story and made a graph on the wall to show our favourites.
