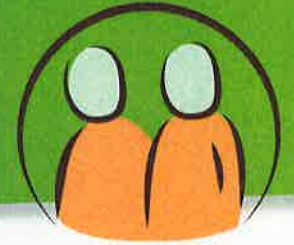

# ONLINE DANGERS – CLASS 5

Class 5 have learned about the internet dangers and how these continue to grow and change. Here is some information / advice on scams, malware and your digital footprint from Alyvia:

## Safe site symbol:



To begin, a safe site symbol means that the website is safe and reliable. Whereas, if it doesn't have the padlock/safe icon, you are taking a risk. If it doesn't have a safe site symbol, this is what could happen:

- ★ You could see something inappropriate or not suitable
- ★ A virus could hack into your device

Plus, many more dangerous things.



## Why should you never click on pop-up ads?

Considering the evidence, I infer, you should never, ever click on pop-up ads. Pop-up ads seem very innocent however, they are **not**. When you click on them all sorts of viruses could enter into your device and spread. In addition, pop-up ads seem harmless, although, you should never trust them.



## What are "phishing" scams?
